Witnessed the largest "whoomphs" I have ever felt (that's saying something since last December/Jan was horrendous), interestingly much of this was felt returning on the same skin <u>track</u>, telling me this is a stubborn layer that may not give right away. The largest was a collapse in a meadow nearly 0.25 miles long."
